### Sample Rewrite (Answers May Vary):

### Sample Extra Challenge Answer:

### Teacher Guide/Notes:

- Accept different sequence words as long as they fit the meaning and maintain correct order.

- Encourage students to experiment with variety (e.g., *at first*, *eventually*, *in the end*).
