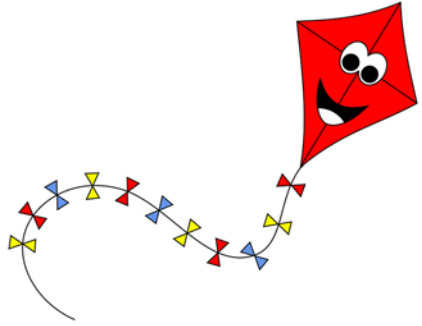

## Kite Adventure Rewrite
