Teacher's Guide

- Review what it means to **rhyme** by saying pairs aloud and listening for the matching ending sounds.
- Support students by modeling one example and pointing out how the beginning sounds can differ while the endings match.
- For students who need extra help, let them clap the word endings or stretch out the last part of the words.
- For extension, ask students to create their own rhyming pair for any sh word, or write a short silly sentence using one rhyme pair.
