3. Sample concise response: The author shapes a cautious perspective by pairing factual evidence about improved safety with a firsthand moment of discomfort under surveillance. This contrast encourages readers to recognize both the benefits and the hidden costs of smart traffic cameras.

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Differentiation Tips**

- Provide a short checklist for struggling writers: identify perspective, identify one method, explain effect.
- Allow students to outline their response in bullet form before writing.
- Challenge advanced students to name two techniques and compare their impact.

- **Engagement Ideas**

- Hold a brief class discussion on safety versus privacy.
- Ask students to underline where the author shifts tone.
- Invite students to vote on whether the passage feels more supportive or more cautious.

- **Extension Activities**

- Have students rewrite one paragraph to strengthen the opposite perspective.
- Assign a quick research task on real world smart city cameras.
- Ask students to write a short editorial using one data point and one personal example.
