Doctor Prompt: Time for a Checkup!

Sometimes long prompts try to do too much at once. They can repeat themselves, give confusing instructions, or even contradict themselves. This makes it harder for the AI to follow. A good prompt should still have detail, but it also needs to be clear, consistent, and easy to understand.

Directions - Read each messy long prompt carefully. Notice where it is confusing, repetitive, or contradictory. Then rewrite it into a cleaner, still detailed version that keeps the important parts but removes the clutter.

Messy Prompt 1 - "Write a story about a young wizard who lives in a magical school. The wizard should be brave and also scared at the same time, but don't make them too scared because they're supposed to be brave. The story should be funny but also serious and dramatic. It should be about 500 words, but also shorter than 300 words so it's quick to read."

Messy Prompt 2 - "Explain how plants grow through photosynthesis, but don't talk about photosynthesis too much, just focus on how plants make their own food. Make it very simple like for a young child, but also use advanced science vocabulary so it looks smart. The explanation should be in one paragraph, but make sure it is at least two or three paragraphs long so it looks complete."
