Classification of Instructions

1. *Make the story about a pirate who is brave but also very cowardly.*
Essential. This sets the main character and personality traits.
2. *Keep the story short, around 200 words, but also make sure it is long enough to feel detailed, like 500 words.*
Confusing. The word count instructions contradict each other (200 vs. 500).
3. *Use exciting action scenes with sword fights and treasure hunts.*
Essential. This adds clear direction for the story's content.
4. *End the story with a surprising twist.*
Essential. This gives the story a specific structure and ending requirement.
5. *Write it like a poem in rhyming couplets, but also like a news article reporting real events.*
Confusing. These two styles clash and are nearly impossible to combine effectively.
6. *Include at least two supporting characters who help the pirate on their journey.*
Optional. This adds depth but isn't necessary for the story to make sense.
