## Who's in Control Here? - The Prompt Power Ranking Game

Some prompts give the AI a lot of freedom, while others give very strict instructions. We call this the **level of control**. Short prompts are more open-ended, while long prompts are more specific.

**Directions** - Read the six prompts below. Rank them from **1 (most open-ended, least control)** to **6 (most specific, most control)**. Then explain your choices for the prompt you ranked #1 and the one you ranked #6.

### The Prompts

\_\_\_\_\_ A. "Tell me something interesting."

\_\_\_\_\_ B. "Write a 5-sentence summary of the book *Charlotte's Web*, focusing only on the main character Wilbur."

\_\_\_\_\_ C. "Create a poem."

\_\_\_\_\_ D. "Write a 2-paragraph letter to the school principal, politely requesting longer lunch periods. Include two reasons and keep the tone respectful."

\_\_\_\_\_ E. "Describe a city."

\_\_\_\_\_ F. "Write a short story about a detective who solves a mystery using only clues found in a library. Keep the story under 200 words and end with a twist."
