

## Sight Word Stack Answer Key

### Sample Fluent Responses

1. Students should read each pyramid with smooth phrasing and correct sight word recognition.
2. Example fluent readings include:
  - "I can read books" said with natural rhythm and pacing.
  - "They can play outside" read without pauses or monotone delivery.
3. Reflection answers will vary but may include:
  - "Easiest: #2 because I knew all the words."
  - "Hardest: #10 because the sentence was longer."
  - "Strategies: Practicing rereads and grouping words together."

### Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose:** This exercise reinforces **automaticity** with sight words while building **smooth phrasing**.
- **Implementation Tips:**
  - Model one pyramid first for tone, phrasing, and pacing.
  - Have students echo-read each line, then perform independently.
  - Encourage repeated readings (3× per pyramid) to strengthen memory and fluency.
  - Use a timer for a "Fluency Challenge" where students aim to improve time with accuracy.
- **Extension Option:** Allow students to create their own sight word pyramids using class sight word lists.
