Examples of Correct Underlining (Bolded for Clarity):

1. **Where** did you put your shoes this morning?
2. I know **where** my backpack is, but not my hat.
3. Can you show me **where** the pencils are?
4. The teacher asked **where** we were sitting for lunch.
5. **Where** is the library in this school?
6. My mom told me **where** to wait after class.
7. We played a game to see **where** the treasure was hidden.
8. Do you remember **where** we went last weekend?

Teacher Notes / Guide

Objective: To develop **automatic recognition** and **fluent use** of a single sight word in multiple sentence contexts while improving **reading speed and expression** through repetition.

Implementation Tips:

- Introduce the word "where" visually on the board. Discuss its meaning (asking for a place).
- Model reading the first two sentences aloud, showing what smooth phrasing sounds like.
- Encourage **three rereads** per sentence: first for accuracy, second for phrasing, third for fluency.
