From One to Another Answer Key

Sample Answers - Student answers may vary

1. Compound: The dog barked at the stranger, and the cat hid.
Complex: The dog barked at the stranger because it was afraid.
2. Compound: She opened the window, and fresh air filled the room.
Complex: She opened the window because it was too warm.
3. Simple: I didn't go to the park.
Complex: I didn't go to the park because it started to rain.
4. Simple: He played guitar with his sister.
Complex: He played the guitar while his sister sang along.
5. Simple: I passed the test.
Compound: I studied hard, so I passed the test.
6. Simple: She smiled at her friend.
Compound: She saw her friend, and she smiled.

Teacher Notes:

- Accept **any correct variations** as long as they follow sentence-type rules.
- Encourage students to **underline conjunctions** to show how they changed the sentence type.
- For advanced learners, challenge them to create **two different transformations** (e.g., use *because* or *when* in a complex sentence).
