Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Objective:** Practice forming and applying **simple past tense verbs** in a meaningful story context.
- **Method:** Students use verb clues in parentheses to transform base verbs into past tense, reinforcing both recognition and production.
- **Differentiation:**
 - For beginners: Provide a verb word bank with past tense forms.
 - For advanced learners: Remove the base verbs in parentheses so students must choose the correct verbs independently.
- **Extension Idea:** Have students continue the story with **5 original sentences** using different simple past verbs.
