

## Flipping Tenses Twice Answer Key

1. Negative: They did not play soccer after school.

Interrogative: Did they play soccer after school?

2. Negative: Maria did not visit her grandmother on Sunday.

Interrogative: Did Maria visit her grandmother on Sunday?

3. Negative: We did not finish our homework before dinner.

Interrogative: Did we finish our homework before dinner?

4. Negative: He did not travel to Japan last summer.

Interrogative: Did he travel to Japan last summer?

5. Negative: I did not buy a new backpack yesterday.

Interrogative: Did I buy a new backpack yesterday?

6. Negative: The children did not paint a big picture in art class.

Interrogative: Did the children paint a big picture in art class?

7. Negative: My father did not cook pasta for dinner.

Interrogative: Did my father cook pasta for dinner?

8. Negative: The students did not study for the science test.

Interrogative: Did the students study for the science test?

9. Negative: She did not open the window because it was hot.

Interrogative: Did she open the window because it was hot?

Interrogative: Did we celebrate my birthday at a restaurant?

### Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Differentiation:**

- For beginners: Start with simpler verbs (e.g., "I played" → "I did not play").
- For advanced learners: Add time expressions and irregular verbs for more challenge.
