School Day Routine Answer Key

(Student answers will vary, but all sentences must correctly use the *simple present tense*. Below are sample answers.)

1. I **wake up** at 6:30 a.m.
2. I **eat** eggs and toast for breakfast.
3. I **go** to school by bus.
4. I **study** math and English in class.
5. I **eat** lunch with my friends.
6. I **play** basketball after school.
7. I **eat** rice and chicken for dinner.
8. I **read** a book before bed.

Bonus Example:

- I **sing** in the shower every morning.
- I **dance** in my room before dinner.

Teacher Notes

- This worksheet encourages **personal connection** with grammar by having students use **real-life routines**.
- Watch for **subject-verb agreement errors** (e.g., "He wakes up," not "He wake up").
- Extension: Students can write their routine in **paragraph form** and share with a partner for peer feedback.
- Differentiation: Beginners may write short, simple sentences. Advanced students can expand with **sequence words** (first, then, after, finally).
