Teacher Notes / Guide

Purpose: This worksheet builds **skimming and scanning fluency** by training students to quickly recognize **quotation patterns** and associate dialogue with speakers. It improves reading speed, comprehension of text structure, and expressive oral fluency.

Implementation Tips:

- Set a **3-minute timer** for the scanning portion; students can use **quotation marks** as visual anchors.
- Emphasize that quotes often reveal **character tone and motivation**, which enhances both understanding and fluency.

Extension Ideas:

- Ask students to **rewrite one quote** in their own words while keeping the same meaning.
- Challenge them to create **two new lines of dialogue** that could fit naturally into the story.
- Use color-coding: highlight each character's quotes in a different color to reinforce **speaker identification** visually.
