## Problem-Solution Pairs Answer Key

1 → C. Jonah's friend shared a sandwich with him at lunch.

2 → E. Mia's family used candles until the power came back on.

3 → D. Daniel's neighbor helped him fix the chain with tools.

4 → A. Her teacher gave her tape to fix it before presenting.

5 → B. The team had a meeting and agreed to share the ball more.

### Teacher Notes

- Encourage students to read carefully for logical connections. (E.g., a bike chain cannot be solved by tape, so they must think critically.)
- Accept equivalent wording if students retell solutions in their own words.
- Extension idea: After matching, ask students to **write their own short problem and a possible solution** to add to the chart.
- Differentiation: For struggling readers, provide visual icons (e.g., sandwich, candle, bike, tape, soccer ball) to help them connect problem to solution.
