## Chore Conflict Answer Key

**Conflict Type:** Person vs. Person - The siblings are in direct conflict with each other over chores.

**Possible Resolutions (examples students may write):**

- They agree to split the chores and work together so they can finish quickly.
- Ryan decides to clean this time, and Sophie promises to do the next turn.
- They ask their mom to create a chore chart to make the turns fair and clear.

### Teacher Notes

- Answers should clearly connect to **Person vs. Person** since the struggle is between Sophie and Ryan.
- Accept multiple solutions as long as they are logical, realistic, and show a resolution.
- Extension idea: Have students **rewrite the passage** with their chosen resolution added as the ending.
- Differentiation: For younger students, offer sentence starters such as *"The conflict is..."* or *"The siblings could solve this by..."*
