Teacher's Guide

- Highlight how transition words help readers follow the order of events in a narrative.
- Support students who need help by guiding them to look for time clues in each sentence.
- Remind students that transitions like **first**, **then**, **meanwhile**, and **finally** show beginning, middle, and end structure.
- Differentiation ideas:
 - Provide picture cards showing the sequence for visual learners.
 - Offer extra transition options for advanced learners and ask them to explain why each one fits or does not fit.
- Extension ideas:
 - Have students rewrite the passage using completely different transitions.
 - Invite students to write a new four-sentence story that uses all four transition words correctly.
