8. Neither the dog nor the cats **were** making noise yesterday, but they **make** noise today.

Teacher Notes

- This worksheet blends two common problem areas: **agreement** and **tense consistency**.
- Watch for singular tricky nouns (“each,” “news,” “committee,” “bouquet”) that *sound plural*.
- Encourage students to **underline subjects first** and then check verb endings.
- Helpful teaching tip: Ask students to label each verb with a **T (tense)** and **A (agreement)** as they edit.
