

Buzzing With Agreement Answer Key

Sample Responses

1. Honeybees help pollinate many plants.
 - "Honeybees" is plural → "help."
2. The queen lays eggs in the bee colony.
 - "Queen" is singular → "lays."
3. Thousands of worker bees usually make up a colony.
 - "Bees" is plural → "make."
4. Worker bees collect nectar and pollen.
 - "Bees" plural → "collect."
5. Plants struggle to grow when pollination does not occur.
 - "Plants" is plural → "struggle."

Teacher Notes

- This activity blends **reading comprehension** with **grammar practice**, giving students an authentic reason to use correct agreement.
- Encourage students to always **rewrite the full sentence** in their answer (not just the verb choice).
- Extension: Ask students to **write two new questions** about the passage and swap with a partner to answer.
