## Form-Fit Table Answer Key

Verb: to be

Subject Pronoun	Verb Form (to be)
I	am
You	are
He/She/It	is
We	are
They	are

Verb: to have

Subject Pronoun	Verb Form (to have)
I	have
You	have
He/She/It	has
We	have
They	have

Verb: to run (present tense)

Subject Pronoun	Verb Form (to run)
I	run
You	run
He/She/It	runs
We	run
They	run

### Teacher Notes

- This table activity works well as a **visual anchor** for patterns in subject-verb agreement.
- Highlight how **only third-person singular (he, she, it)** changes form in regular present tense verbs (e.g., run → runs).
- Reinforce irregular verbs like **to be** and **to have**, since students often confuse these.
- Extension idea: Ask students to create **three original sentences** for each verb, using different pronouns.
