Teacher's Guide

- Have students rewrite each problem vertically before allowing them to solve.
- Remind students that decimal points must be directly above one another.
- Encourage students to add trailing zeros when needed, such as writing 5.9 as 5.90.
- Model one example together before students work independently.
- Pair students to check each other's vertical setup before calculating.
- Ask students to explain why lining up digits by place value is important.
- Challenge early finishers to create three horizontal subtraction problems for a partner to rewrite and solve.
- Extend learning by having students estimate each difference before finding the exact answer.
