Teacher's Guide

- Have students solve all problems before looking at the answer cards.
- Encourage students to eliminate used cards as they complete each match.
- Remind students to line up decimal points when subtracting.
- Allow students to verify their matches with a partner before checking answers.
- Support students by providing graph paper to help align place values.
- Challenge advanced students to write two new subtraction problems that match two of the unused answer values from a different set.
- Turn the activity into a partner game by cutting out the answer cards and having students physically match them to the problems.
- Extend the lesson by asking students to create their own set of four subtraction problems and matching answer cards for a classmate.
