Teacher's Guide

- Quick implementation tips
 - Review that only the numerators are subtracted when denominators are the same.
 - Have students check that the denominator stays the same.
- Differentiation strategies
 - Provide fraction strips or circles for students who need visual support.
 - Challenge advanced students to explain why the denominator does not change.
 - Pair students to compare and discuss their simplification steps.
- Engagement ideas
 - Let students solve in pairs and check each other's work.
 - Turn the worksheet into a timed fluency challenge after guided practice.
 - Ask students to identify which answers are equivalent before simplifying.
- Extension activities
 - Have students write three new subtraction problems with like denominators for a classmate.
 - Invite students to order five of the answers from least to greatest.
