Teacher's Guide:

• Differentiation Tips:

- For younger students, begin with two-level pyramids (base + one suffix).
- For advanced students, introduce multiple suffix combinations or have them justify how each new word's meaning changes.
- Engagement Idea: Create a "Word Builder Challenge" where students race to build the tallest, most logical word pyramid from a single base word.

Extension Activities:

- Have students write short sentences using each word form to show how context changes.
- Encourage them to find other base words that can climb to three or four levels.
