Teacher's Guide:

- **Skill Focus:** Students compare and contrast **suffix pairs** that share meanings but follow different **spelling and usage patterns**, reinforcing morphological awareness and orthographic rules.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide struggling learners with **visual suffix cards** showing patterns (e.g., *-ate* → *-or*).
 - Challenge advanced learners to **find exceptions** or research Latin-based roots for *-ible* words.
- **Engagement Idea:** Make it interactive with a "**Suffix Duel**" game-students hold up "-er" or "-or" cards after hearing base words read aloud.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to **write two original sentences** per suffix pair showing correct usage.
 - Encourage them to create a **mini suffix dictionary** explaining when to use each ending.
 - Integrate word origin exploration by having students discover which suffix comes from **Old English** (-er) and which from **Latin** (-or, -ible).
