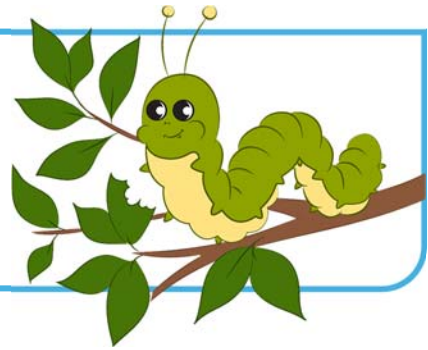


Garden Discovery
