Narrative Sample Answer: Talia practiced riding her bike for weeks and finally learned to ride by herself.

Informative Sample Answer: Honeybees help plants grow by spreading pollen, which supports many of the foods people eat.

Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet builds **concise summarizing skills** by requiring students to identify only the most important idea.
- Remind students that a strong one-sentence summary includes the **who or what** and the **main action or purpose**.
- For differentiation, allow struggling writers to first list three key details, then turn them into one sentence.
- For engagement, let students share their summaries aloud and discuss which ones are the clearest.
- For extension, challenge students to revise their summaries using stronger verbs or clearer noun phrases.
- Pair students to compare the **narrative** and **informative** summaries and discuss how they differ in focus.
