

Geo Terms Pair-Up Answer Key

1. Archipelago: A group of islands located close together.
2. Fjäll: A high mountain area found in northern Scandinavia.
3. Peninsula: A piece of land almost surrounded by water but still connected to the mainland.
4. Sustainability: The practice of using resources in ways that protect the environment for the future.
5. Urbanization: The growth of cities as more people move from rural areas to urban communities.
6. Lapland: A region in northern Sweden known for the Sami people, reindeer herding, and cold subarctic climates.

Teacher's Guide

- Review each bold term with the class before students begin writing definitions.
- Encourage students to use their own words rather than copying from a source.
- After completion, compare student definitions and clarify any misconceptions.

Engagement Ideas

- Show photos of an archipelago, fjäll, and a peninsula to help students visualize the terms.
- Create a class word wall with these and other Swedish geography terms.
- Have students guess each term from a teacher provided clue before revealing the definitions.

Extension Activities

- Ask students to use three of the vocabulary terms in a short paragraph about Sweden.
- Invite students to research Lapland in more detail, including culture, climate, and wildlife.
