Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This worksheet builds **vocabulary precision** by helping students recognize **intensity levels in synonyms**, an essential skill for nuanced writing and emotional expression.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **younger students**, discuss each word's "strength" using emotion scales (e.g., how angry vs. furious feels).
 - For **older students**, encourage them to justify their order choices using real-world examples or context clues.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play a "**Synonym Thermometer**" game: students move words up or down on an imaginary thermometer based on their intensity.
 - Use expressive reading-students say each word louder or softer to match its emotional strength.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students find or create new synonym trios (e.g., walk → jog → sprint).
 - Challenge advanced learners to write short sentences using all three levels of a synonym group to show tonal progression.
