Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Use a "**Tone Test**" game-read a sentence aloud using different synonyms and have students guess which fits best.
 - Invite students to rewrite one sentence for three different audiences (a friend, a teacher, and a newspaper).
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Encourage learners to find examples of precise synonym use in news articles, stories, or essays.
