Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity helps students **visually recognize synonym relationships** through color association, reinforcing **semantic understanding** and **word recall**.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **younger learners**, read each word aloud before they color and discuss what each one means.
 - For **older students**, increase difficulty by adding near-synonyms or slightly different connotations (e.g., *furious*, *content*, *whispering*).
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn it into a "**Synonym Rainbow Race**" - students color pairs as fast as they can while explaining why they belong together.
 - Let students choose their own color legend (e.g., warm colors for emotions, cool colors for size words).
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students create their own list of synonym pairs and color them for classmates to solve.
 - Ask them to use each pair in a short story or sentence to show how synonyms can change tone or intensity.
