Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This worksheet develops students' understanding of **synonyms in context**, showing how word choice affects **tone, imagery, and sentence variety** in descriptive writing.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **younger learners**, read the passage aloud and discuss what each word means using physical motion (pretend to move "swiftly," "speedily," or "rapidly").
 - For **older students**, highlight nuances - e.g., "rapid" fits natural forces, while "swift" fits animals or actions.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a **"Synonym Safari" scavenger hunt** where students find synonym pairs in other classroom texts or nature descriptions.
 - Let students illustrate one of the animals from the passage and label it with different synonyms for "fast."
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to rewrite the paragraph using new synonym sets (e.g., "tiny," "small," "minute").
 - Encourage them to write their own mini adventure using three related synonyms to show tone variation.
