Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity builds **synonym awareness** and strengthens **context-based vocabulary skills**, helping students express ideas with more variety and precision.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **early readers**, read sentences aloud and discuss what each bold word means before asking for replacements.
 - For **older or advanced learners**, encourage using less common or more vivid synonyms (e.g., "exhausted" instead of "tired").
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play "**Synonym Swap Relay**": students take turns saying a synonym for a given word as quickly as possible.
 - Have pairs read the sentences aloud using both the original and swapped word to compare how tone changes.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Challenge students to write new sentences using their synonym choices.
 - Create a "**Word Swap Wall**" in class where students post synonym pairs they discover in their reading.
