Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read each scenario aloud and discuss vocabulary words like "sarcastic" or "tone."
 - Provide sentence starters for students needing structure, such as "A calm response would be..."
 - Use small-group role-play to model correct responses before the quiz.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the worksheet into a "Conflict Detective" activity where students explain how each correct answer de-escalates tension.
 - Have students act out two endings for a scenario-one respectful and one unhelpful-then discuss which felt better.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to write their own brief online conflict scenario with four possible choices, including one calm solution.
