Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read the passage aloud for auditory learners and pause to explain vocabulary like "misunderstood" or "tone."
 - Offer sentence starters for reflection responses such as "He could have prevented it by..."
 - Allow extra processing time for students who need it when answering open-ended questions.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students act out a short skit showing a misunderstanding and then a respectful resolution.
 - Discuss as a class how emojis, punctuation, and timing can affect how messages are received.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to rewrite Jordan's original message in a way that avoids confusion.
