

## Tea Timeline Tangle

**Directions**: Read the six events below describing key moments from the Tea Act through the First Continental Congress. Number them **1-6** to show the correct order in which they happened.

A. Representatives from twelve colonies meet in Philadelphia to discuss how
to respond to the Intolerable Acts, forming the First Continental Congress.
B. British Parliament passes a law allowing the East India Company to sell tea
directly to the colonies, reducing costs but keeping the tax-this becomes known
as the Tea Act.
C. Colonists protest the Tea Act by boarding British ships in Boston Harbor and
dumping tea into the water during the Boston Tea Party.
D. Britain reacts to colonial defiance by enacting the Intolerable Acts, which
close Boston Harbor and tighten control over Massachusetts.
E. News of the Intolerable Acts spreads through the colonies, leading many to
send supplies and support to Boston in unity.
F. British officials demand payment for the destroyed tea, but the colonists
refuse, further increasing tension between Britain and the colonies.
