### Teacher's Guide

- Begin by explaining what **Patriots** and **Loyalists** believed during the time of the Boston Tea Party.
- Model one example aloud and discuss clue words that reveal a speaker's loyalty (e.g., "freedom," "King," "law").
- **Differentiation strategies:**
  - For emerging readers, provide a word bank with "Patriot" and "Loyalist" next to simple definitions.
  - Challenge advanced learners to write one original quote for each side.
- **Engagement idea:** Conduct a quick class debate where students read one quote aloud and the class decides which side said it.
- **Extension activity:** Have students write a short paragraph explaining which side they would have joined and why, using at least one example from the worksheet.
