Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Reinforce student knowledge of key figures from the Civil Rights Movement through comprehension and context matching.
- **Engagement Tip:** Before beginning, show short images or posters of each leader and ask students to share what they already know.
- **Differentiation:**
 - For younger or struggling readers, reduce the number of leaders and provide sentence starters or highlighted clues.
 - For advanced students, challenge them to add one additional fact about each leader.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students write a short paragraph about which leader inspires them most and why.
 - Create a "Hall of Courage" wall display with student illustrations of each Civil Rights hero.
 - Integrate with ELA by having students compare two leaders' approaches to achieving equality.
