Teacher's Guide

Engagement Ideas:

- Turn this into a "Cold War Map Challenge": project or display a blank world map and have students label alliances visually.
- Play a "Which Side Are You On?" game, where students move to corners of the classroom representing NATO, Warsaw Pact, or Non-Aligned.

Extension Ideas:

- Have students research how one non-aligned nation balanced relations with both sides.
- Ask: "If you were a world leader in the 1950s, which alliance (if any) would you choose and why?"
- Encourage students to explore how modern alliances, such as the European Union or NATO today, trace their origins back to the Cold War.
