### Teacher's Guide

#### Tips for Differentiation:

- **For emerging learners:** Provide visual symbols for each policy (e.g., airplane for Berlin Airlift, handshake for SALT).
- **For advanced learners:** Ask students to explain how two of these policies worked together to strengthen U.S. strategy.
- **For English language learners:** Review the meanings of "doctrine," "containment," and "agreement" before beginning.

#### Engagement Ideas:

- Use a "Cold War Policy Relay" where students take turns explaining each policy to teammates in their own words.
- Host a "Policy Match Debate," where pairs defend which policy had the greatest global impact.

#### Extension Ideas:

- Have students write a short reflection on whether these policies reduced or intensified Cold War tensions.
- Connect the policies to modern foreign relations, discussing how containment principles appear in today's international conflicts.
