- 2. "I'm made of layers of sand that have been pressed together over time. Lately, I've been pushed deeper into the crust where it's hotter and the pressure is intense."
- 3. "I was a smooth pebble in a riverbed. Over millions of years, I got buried and cemented together with other pebbles. But now I'm melting far below the surface."
- 4. "I was once a volcanic rock at the surface, but now I'm being ground down into fine particles and carried to the ocean floor."
- 5. "I'm a piece of shale, and I've been squeezed and heated until my texture and minerals have completely changed."
- 6. "I was a marble statue, but over time I've been exposed to rain mixed with carbon dioxide, wearing me away bit by bit."
