## Sample Critical Thinking Response:

Fishermen and sailors rely on tide knowledge because tides decide when boats can safely leave or enter harbors. At high tide, water is deep enough for ships to move, but at low tide, some areas may be too shallow. Tides also affect when fish gather in certain places, making it easier or harder to catch them. Knowing the tide schedule keeps people safe and helps them plan their work more successfully.

## Sample Reflection Extension Response:

Modern technology helps predict tides more accurately, but people still need to understand natural tidal patterns. Technology can fail, but observing the Moon and knowing about spring and neap tides keeps communities prepared.
