- $4 \rightarrow A$  (Neap Tide = least difference between high and low tides, when Sun, Earth, and Moon form a right angle)

• Example: High tide affects fishermen because it can change when they can safely bring boats in and out of harbor. It also influences when beach areas are covered with water, which matters for visitors and local businesses.
