Teacher Notes / Guide

Objective: Students will develop **fluency with comprehension balance** by reading a narrative passage under timed conditions and demonstrating recall accuracy afterward.

Implementation Tips:

- Emphasize that **fluency isn't just speed**; it's reading with accuracy and understanding.
- Have students read aloud in pairs, timing one another with a stopwatch or online timer.
- After the comprehension questions, ask students to identify **which sentences they remembered most clearly** and why.
- Reinforce **metacognitive reflection**: students should note how pacing, focus, or anxiety affected their recall.

Extension Options:

- Have students graph WPM results over time to visualize fluency progress.
- Integrate cross-curricular connection: discuss **navigation tools** in science or geography lessons (maps, compasses, GPS).
