

Lighthouse Relay Answer Key

Comprehension Answers:

1. The beam had gone dark mysteriously three nights earlier.
2. Clara's cousin Jake joined her.
3. She froze when she saw a shadow move inside the lighthouse.
4. Possible answers: A person signaling, someone repairing the light, or something mysterious like a hidden figure; students may infer any reasonable explanation.

Fluency Notes for Teachers:

- Each student will likely read 30–50 words during their 20-second turn, depending on fluency level.
- Encourage groups to note improvement in **smoothness and expression** during a second round of reading.
- Average accuracy target: 95% or higher across the group.

Teacher Notes / Guide

Objective: Students build fluency through **cooperative timed reading**, improving their rhythm, expression, and confidence while maintaining continuity in a narrative text.

Implementation Tips:

- Have each group member hold their place visually as others read to ensure a smooth handoff.
- Assign one student as the **timekeeper** and another as the **tracker** to record errors and smoothness ratings.
- After each full round, discuss what made the group sound most fluent; focus on **intonation and pacing**.
- Use the comprehension questions to reinforce that **fluency and understanding work together**.
