- 1. **EF1** Cars pushed off roads, but not lifted.
- 2. **EF3** Severe damage includes entire stories of houses destroyed.
- 3. **EFO** 65-85 mph, light damage like broken branches and minor roof damage.
- 4. EF2 Cars lifted and large trees snapped match EF2.
- 5. **Sample Answer**: Meteorologists use the EF scale because it connects wind speed to actual damage, which helps people understand the storm's impact, not just the numbers.
