## **Safety Checklist For Tornadoes**

**Directions**: Tornadoes can be extremely dangerous, but knowing what to do can save lives. Below is a list of actions people might take during a tornado. Some are safe choices, and some are unsafe. Place a check  $(\checkmark)$  next to SAFE actions and an X-mark (X) next to UNSAFE actions.

- 1. Go to the basement or the lowest floor of the building.
- 2. Stand by a window to watch the tornado.
- 3. Hide under a sturdy table or workbench for protection.
- 4. Drive away from the tornado as fast as possible, even into crowded roads.
- 5. Cover your head and neck with your arms or a blanket.
- 6. Stay inside a mobile home until the storm passes.
- 7. Move to a small, windowless room like a bathroom or closet.
- 8. Open all the windows to "equalize the pressure."
- 9. Listen to weather alerts from a battery-powered radio.
- 10. Shelter inside a car parked under a bridge.
