Teacher Notes

- This worksheet moves beyond single-sentence practice to **multi-sentence flow**, so students see how transitions shape whole paragraphs.
- Some sentences intentionally don't require a transition. This teaches students that overusing connectors can make writing clunky.
- Encourage students to read each passage aloud once completed. Hearing the flow helps them confirm whether their chosen transition works.
- Extension: Have students write their own short 4-5 sentence paragraph with at least three transitions, then swap with a partner to "fill in" different ones.
