### Tips for Use

- Demonstrate first: "Pinch, lift, and place softly in the nest."

#### **Differentiation Ideas**

- For beginners: use larger "eggs" (ping pong balls or cotton balls).
- For advanced learners: use smaller items (fuzzy pom-poms or beads).

## **Engagement Boosters**

- Tell a mini story: "The mama bird needs your help filling her nests!"
- Play bird chirping sounds for an immersive environment.
- Let children name each baby bird before starting.
