## **Ukraine Comparison Answer Key**

- 1. Students should mention features such as cold winters, warm summers, or continental climate patterns, along with a comparison to the selected country.
- 2. Possible Ukrainian landforms include the **Carpathians**, **steppe**, or **Black Sea** coastline. Students should compare to a mountain range, coastline, or plains in their chosen country.
- 3. Cultural responses may include Ukrainian dance, music, foods, or holidays. Students must compare with a tradition from their chosen country.
- 4. Students should mention Ukraine's eastern location and continental climate and compare it to the other country's position.
- 5. Answers should show at least one similarity and one difference in climate, landforms, or culture.

## **Engagement Ideas**
